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Old Business

1. Approval of Minutes of Budget Hearing on 29 September 2025
2. A motion was made by Commissioner Brummett and seconded by Commissioner Huete to accept the minutes as presented from the Budget Hearing. Motion approved.

New Business

1. Open Board Position: Commissioner Lang shared that Commissioner Burton has resigned his position for personal reasons. Per our Florida statutes the Commission will appoint a new Commissioner to fill the remainder of that term. We have two possible candidates that have expressed interest and will have the opportunity to meet with any of the Commissioners to discuss the position. A decision will be made by the next meeting.
2. Union Contract: Chief Fureigh updated from the Union that our firefighters acknowledge how tight our current budget is and have agreed to accept the current contract but have requested an increase for Holiday Pay from \$166.67 to \$250 which has already been built into the budget and has been approved.

Comments or Announcements

Ms. Skelly asked Chief Fureigh if "call counts" include accidents. Chief Fureigh explained that those numbers include everything from medical, fire, goodwill etc. She also asked the results of the study to determine how many residents and SPR's have been completed. Chief Fureigh confirmed the study has not been completed. Ms. Skelly asked if the Chief or the Commissioners select who will fill the vacant seat. Commissioner Lang explained that it is a decision of the Commissioners.

Mr. Lambert asked how he could obtain copies of the Chief's Report, Beach Safety Report and Treasurer's Report. Chief Fureigh said that we would email a copy of these reports to him. Mr. Lambert then asked under what authority the Commission has to fill the open position. Commissioner Lang explained again that it is a Florida statute in which we will fill this position.

Motion to Adjourn was made by Commissioner Huete and seconded by Commissioner Pasvantis. Motion approved. Meeting Adjourned at 5:10 pm.
